Crossness Southern Marshes Greenwich/Bexley



Friday 18th Sept - 19:00 • Easy walk + bat detecting

Start and Finish: Southmere Lake car park off Belvedere Road.
(expected to end between 21:00 and 21:30)

Accessibility: Accessible for all, except large mobility chairs .

Travel by Bus: 229 & 244.

Nearest Train Station: Nearest train station is Abbey Wood.

Evening travel made safer: Meet a member of the Green Chain Team at Abbey Wood train station and walk with them to the start of the walk. They will be there at 18:15. For your added security the Green Chain team will also return to the station after the walk.

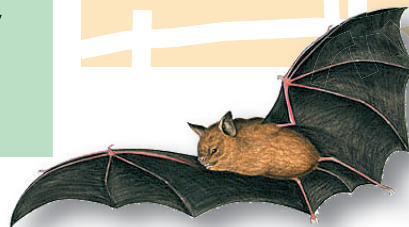
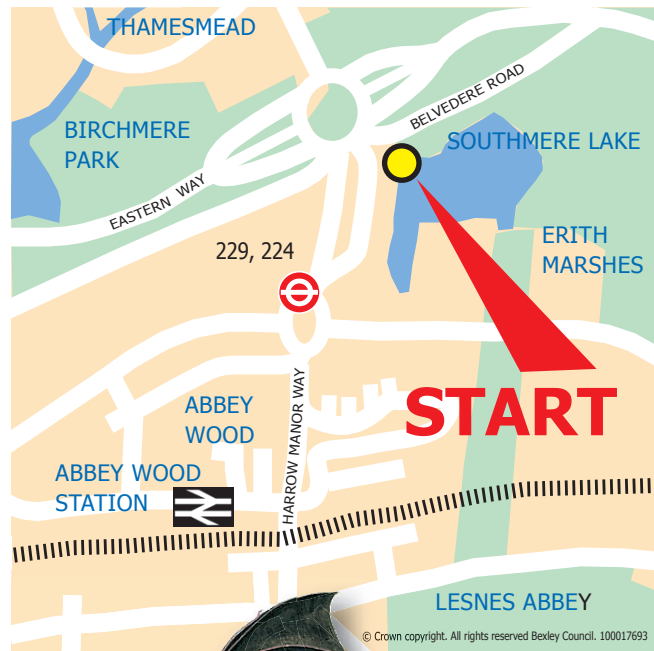
Facilities: No toilets or refreshments.

About the walk:

Why not take a nocturnal look at Crossness Southern Marshes? See four or more different bat species as they prepare for mating season and the pre-hibernation feeding frenzy. Have a go with a bat detector. The walk will be led by Karen Sutton, the manager of the marshes, who will tell you all about the wildlife living there. Great for children and adults; a rare opportunity to safely explore the marshes at night.
