Avery Hill Park Greenwich



Thursday 17th Sept - 11:00 • Short walk

Start and Finish: Outside the Winter Garden (glasshouse) in Avery Hill Park.

Accessibility: Accessible for all – but ground can be soft when wet .

Travel by Bus: B15, 132, 162 & 286.

Nearest Train Station: Falconwood

Train travel made easy: Meet a member of the Green Chain Team at Falconwood train station and walk with them to the start of the walk. They will be there at 10:15.

Facilities: Toilets and refreshments (to buy) available at the beginning and end of the walk.

About the walk:

Avery Hill Park is one of the largest parks on the Green Chain Walk and is famous for an iconic nineteenth century greenhouse called the Winter Gardens. The greenhouse is part of a mansion, now owned by the University of Greenwich, built by Colonel North and the park formed part of the landscaped gardens. The park recently won £400k in the Mayor of London's Priority Park project. Meet the friends of Avery Hill Park, enjoy a relaxing walk and hear about the future plans for the park.
